Please join us for a variety of summer programs **beginning June 12**, **2017** designed to help your child develop new skills and refine current ones. Our goal is to have good old-fashioned FUN while working on current IFSP, IEP, and personal goals. The 'camp' programs are for toddlers, preschoolers and school age children. Special programs focusing on social thinking/executive functioning for older students, and a 'Cursive Crash-Course!' are also offered, as well as individualized programs for ESY and tutoring. Summer CAMP Program 6 and 8-week classes available

These programs focus on developmental skills including play and social interaction skills using a combination of <u>Sensory Integration and Floortime</u> techniques. A major emphasis will be placed on sensory, motor, cognitive and speech and language development during activities designed to be fun, interactive, and challenging. The activities are designed to provide additional practice while addressing goals. Children will be grouped by age and skill levels to ensure appropriate programming. <u>Typically developing peers will also be integrated as appropriate and available</u>. (A limited number of spots are available for siblings who can attend as peers at reduced rate.) <u>Although</u> <u>described as 'camp' specific developmental goals are addressed</u>. Staff: OT/Speech/Special Educators

*<u>Minnows</u>-This group is designed for very young children olds who have had limited experience with peers. They may be cautious and hesitant to explore their environment or to separate from their parents or caregivers, and/or interact with peers. Others may have a strong drive to move and have trouble sitting still long enough to focus on books, coloring, or language activities. Activities include a variety of sensorimotor activities to help them learn to move or calm down, to communicate, play and interact. <u>Very limited size due to staffing requirements</u>. **Staff: OT, Speech, and Special Educators** Times: M W F 9:00-11:00.

T Th 8:30-10:30 These sessions will be staffed by a speech pathologist so that in addition to the sensorimotor focus language, communication, and pragmatic/play skills can be emphasized. Activities are designed to address both the ability to understand others and to express oneself. For these sessions, children must be able to sit for short periods of time and attend to activities such as games, circle time, and stories.

*<u>Dolphins</u>-This group is appropriate for children who can handle being in a small group setting but need to move and explore. It includes a variety of movement and sensory experiences to help with fine, gross and language development, and to help them play, share, cooperate, and communicate with peers and adults. The goal is to find activities that help meet their sensory needs and to facilitate interaction, engagement and appropriate participation. Group size will be limited so personal goals can be addressed.

Preschool and Elementary sections available.6 or 8 wks.Staff: OT, Special EducatorsTimes: M T W Th F9:00-11:30 am

*<u>Sharks</u>-This group is appropriate for children who continue to benefit from sensory and motor experiences, but also need a higher level of challenge. It will incorporate many sensorimotor opportunities, but also higher-level cognitive and language skill development. Structured games, imaginative play, fine motor and handwriting practice, gross motor skills, and more reading activities also included. Group size is limited so we can provide as much intensive intervention as possible. 2 xs's per week is recommended due to themes and projects Preschool and Elementary sections available. 6 or 8 wks. Staff: OT, Special Educators Times: M T W Th F 8:30-11:30 am *<u>Stingrays</u> -This group is designed for children who are capable of higher levels of challenges, but also need to focus on essential skills for school success. We will provide more intensive practice with reading and reading comprehension, fine motor skill development including writing, and cooperative or dramatic play. Gross motor activities address skills, but also taking turns, winning and loosing. Pragmatic language skills related to making friends and reading social cues will be incorporated. Children must be capable of attending and focusing in a small group without as much sensory support or supervision, and be able to follow multi-step directions to complete numerous creative activities. 2x's week recommended due to themes and projects 6 or 8 wks. Staff: OT, Special Educators Times: MTW Th F 8:30-11:30 Elementary Age Group

Summer School Programs

<u>Individualized Program/ ESY Services</u>: Does your child need an opportunity for more individualized practice to work on IEP goals, individualized help in any one area, or Extended School Year (ESY) services? This is a unique opportunity to have a program customized for your student's needs. RDI has two licensed teachers, as well as OT, PT, and SLP's who are available to design an individualized program. Programs are held at Rehab Dynamics and will focus on the needs identified. This may include reading, writing, social skill development, self-care and ADL's, as well as other academic needs. **Cost based on services needed and hours of service**, and will be mutually agreed upon beforehand. PT, OT, Speech and Academic/Reading Tutor all can be included. <u>Please call our office manager to discuss options</u>. Spaces fill up quickly for this program so please contact us ASAP.

<u>Tutoring Services/Reading Enhancement</u>: RDI has licensed teachers who are very willing to provide individualized tutoring sessions for your child in areas of need. The services are provided at RDI at a time mutually agreed upon in any subject. Our teachers have extensive experience working with children of all ages and ability levels. They will set up individualized programs to meet your child's needs. **Cost:** \$25.00/hr. **Cost will be** mutually agreed upon before beginning services. <u>Please call or email our office manager to discuss options</u> for days and times, or special requests. This may also be part of Extended School Year Programs (ESY).

<u>Barracudas - Super Social Thinkers</u>: This group is designed for children who have experience in various social settings, but may struggle with reading social cues and applying social skills with their peers. They will meet various super heroes such as 'Super Social Thinker' as he helps them defeat various "not so good social thinkers" such as Rock Brain (he makes us inflexible) and Glassman (he makes us have HUGE overreactions to small problems). Group members will work on a variety of activities and projects designed to help them practice these social skills while learning strategies to use at home and school.

<u>CURSIVE CRASH-COURSE-</u> Want your child to learn the basics of cursive writing since it is not being taught in many schools? Some people feel that it is easier for children to learn this because they don't have to start and stop. Our intense, yet fun, "boot camp" for cursive writing will meet 3 times per week for 2 weeks. Students will practice writing their name and basic cursive letter formations using a multi-sensory approach. <u>'Good' Sports Groups</u>-Does your child struggle in gym, on the playground, or in local sports-oriented programs? Does he or she need additional help to develop better coordination, timing, and the ability to participate on a team? Is it harder to be a friend, make friends, and to develop skills that help maintain friendships? Children with sensory integration disorders, learning disabilities, Asperger's Disorder, ADHD, or other developmental or neurological conditions can be challenged in many social situations.

These groups are designed to help kids learn to participate in social activities including athletic activities, group games, table top/sit down games and have appropriate conversations with peers. We work with each group to help them collaboratively plan activities, get the necessary materials and then participate in what the group has chosen. A big emphasis is placed on developing appropriate conversational skills by challenging them to ask peers questions, listen to what they say, and then respond appropriately based on what they have learned from their friend. Sharing, waiting your turn, conflict resolution, and problem solving are also addressed.

*Good Sports 1This class incorporates basic activities and games that involve cooperation, taking turns, following and being a
leader, and learning the rules and skills for simple games (ex: tug-of-war, parachute games, jump rope, kick ball, etc.).Ages 5-9 yrs.Staff OTClass Size Limited***Every other Friday
Cost \$200. for 4 wks.

<u>*Good Sports 2</u> This class focuses on the refinement of motor and social skills during games, sports, and activities. Kids will be actively involved in setting up activities, deciding who takes what roles, determining teams, etc. Skill development, as well as learning the rules and working with others as part of team, will be emphasized.
