



## 2019 Summer Programs

Please join us for a variety of summer programs **beginning June 10, 2019** designed to help your child develop new skills and refine current ones. Our goal is to have good old-fashioned FUN while working on current IFSP, IEP, and personal goals. The 'camp' programs are for toddlers, preschoolers and school age children. Special programs focusing on life skills, social thinking/executive functioning for older students, as well as individualized programs for ESY and tutoring are also available. ### **Summer CAMP Program 6 and 8-week classes available**

These programs focus on developmental skills including play and social interaction skills using a combination of **Sensory Integration and Floortime** techniques. A major emphasis will be placed on sensory, motor, cognitive and speech and language development during activities designed to be fun, interactive, and challenging. The activities are designed to provide additional practice while addressing goals. Children will be grouped by age and skill levels to ensure appropriate programming. Typically developing peers will also be integrated as appropriate and available. (A limited number of spots are available for siblings who can attend as peers at reduced rate.) **Although described as 'camp' specific developmental goals are addressed.** Staff: OT/Speech/Special Educators

**\*Minnows**- This group is designed for toddlers and very young children. Some may have had limited experience with peers. Others may be cautious and hesitant to explore their environment or to separate from their parents or caregivers. They may have difficulty interacting with peers or communicating their needs. Others may have a strong drive to move and have trouble sitting still long enough to stay sitting for circle time, to focus on books, coloring, or language activities. Activities include a variety of sensorimotor activities to help them learn to move or calm down, to communicate, play and interact. **Very limited size due to high staff: child ratio.**

**Staff: OT, Speech, and Special Educators 6 or 8 wks.**

**Times: M W F 8:30-10:30**

**T 8:30-10:30, Th 8:30-10:30 and 11:00-1:00** These minnow sections are run by a speech pathologist to emphasize communication skills, articulation and pragmatic/play skills along with sensorimotor skills. Activities are designed to address both the children's ability to understand others and to express themselves using a variety of learned strategies and skills. For these sessions, children must be able to understand and follow some basic directions, sit for short periods of time and attend to activities and stories.

**\*\*Contact us prior to registering for special requests, questions about minnows or help determining group.**

**\*Dolphins**- This group is appropriate for children who can handle being in a small group setting and doing group activities, but frequently need to move. It includes a variety of movement and sensory experiences to help with fine, gross and language development, and to help them play, share, cooperate, and communicate with peers and adults. The goal is to find activities that help meet their sensory needs and to facilitate interaction, engagement and appropriate participation. Group size will be limited so personal goals can be addressed.

**Staff: OT, Special Educators**

**Times: M T W Th F**

**9:00-11:30 am**

**\*Sharks**-This group is appropriate for children who continue to benefit from sensory and motor experiences, but also need a higher level of challenge. It will incorporate many sensorimotor opportunities, but also higher-level cognitive and language skill development. Structured games, imaginative play, fine motor and handwriting practice, gross motor skills, and more reading activities also included. Group size is limited so we can provide as much focused intervention as possible. **2 xs's per week is recommended due to themes and projects**

**\*Stingrays** -This group is designed for children who are capable of higher levels of challenges, but also need to focus on essential skills for school success. We will provide more intensive practice with reading and reading comprehension, fine motor skill development including writing, and cooperative or dramatic play. Gross motor activities address skills, but also taking turns, winning and losing. Pragmatic language skills related to making friends and reading social cues will be incorporated. Children must be capable of attending and focusing in a small group without as much sensory support or supervision, and be able to follow multi-step directions to complete numerous creative activities. **2x's week recommended due to themes and projects**

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**PRICING BY CLASS**

Families may choose no# of times per week, day(s) of week, and total number of weeks. Class sizes limited and registration for a particular class will be closed once full. Therapy staff may suggest registration for particular classes based on child's needs or after screening is completed.

A **limited number** of 1:1 aides are available for children who may need more assistance to participate, but *early registration is essential* to arrange this. There is an additional fee and arrangements for this need to be made at time of registration.

**Minnows:**

1x per week

6 wks. = \$ 390.

2x per week

6 wks. = \$ 770.

3x per week

6 wks. = \$ 1140.

**2 hrs. per session**

1x per week 8 wks. = \$ 530.

2x per week 8 wks. = \$ 1040.

3x per week 8 wks. = \$1500.

Note: 3 x a week maximum due to staffing requirements

## Special Programs

**Lunch Bunch**- If your child has therapy services scheduled after camp, or is participating in afternoon programs we can help. JOIN US FOR LUNCH! *You will need to provide lunch* due to the increase in food allergies, but we will help get it ready so they can enjoy it, then supervise them while they relax or play with peers before 'getting back to work'.

**Staff:** Summer Camp Staff    **Time** 11:30-12:30    **Cost** \$ 10.00 per day    **Arrangements can be made on a weekly basis for this service.**

**Independent Kids** -This group is designed to teach kids social skills and functional daily living skills. The kids will have opportunities to practice social interactions with peers and staff as they learn skills such as preparing their own meals, using tools (hammers, wrenches, drills, etc.), organizing materials for a task, setting up and explaining an activity and more. This group is for kids that have the ability to listen and follow multiple step tasks, read and complete basic written directions, but need some help developing great independence.

## **Summer School Programs**

**Individualized Program/ ESY Services:** Does your child need an opportunity for more individualized practice to work on IEP goals, individualized help in any one area, or Extended School Year (ESY) services? This is a unique opportunity to have a program customized for your student's needs. RDI has licensed teachers for individualized programs based on the needs identified. This may include reading, writing, social skill development, as well as other academic needs. **Cost based on services needed and hours of service, and will be mutually agreed upon beforehand. Please call our office manager to discuss options. Spaces fill up quickly.**

**Tutoring Services/Reading Enhancement:** RDI has licensed teachers who are very willing to provide individualized tutoring sessions for your child in any subject. Our teachers have extensive experience working with children of all ages and ability levels. **Cost: \$25.00/hr. Cost will be mutually agreed upon before beginning services. Please contact our office manager to discuss options/ special requests.**

## Registration Information

*Please complete the next 2 page registration form and return those pages ASAP to ensure a spot in the summer programs, space is limited.*

1. Everyone coming to camp programs **must** have a completed registration form. This includes children seen for private therapy services, through Early Intervention, or school programs, as well as children who are coming for the first time. Children will only be added to a class list after the registration form is received and is complete.
2. Prior to participation a screening **must** be completed for all new campers. You will be contacted to schedule this after registration is completed and a \$35.00 screening fee is required at that time. If a child is a current, or former, client of RDI there is no charge for the screening\*\*.
3. In the event of insufficient registration, RDI reserves the right to cancel or reschedule a class. **Classes fill quickly so register early.** *A waiting list will be started if a class fills and additional sections MAY be added.*
3. Discounts are available for *multiple classes, or for siblings.* Contact us for information.
4. If a holiday falls on a class day (i.e. 4<sup>th</sup> July), or the therapist is ill, the class will be re-scheduled.
5. If your child requires 1:1 assistance to participate in a group we can help make this possible. Register early and notify us as soon as possible so we can confirm additional help is available. There is an additional fee of \$10.00 hr. to cover the cost of hiring an additional person who will assist your child.
6. At the time of registration 50 % of total is required to reserve a space. If you are using grants, scholarships, other funding in lieu of deposit please indicate this. We can then work with you to complete registration.
7. FULL PAYMENT IS REQUIRED ONE WEEK BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN. NO REFUNDS AFTER THE 1<sup>st</sup> CLASS.
